Cruises between Moscow and St.Petersburg

Sailing route: The cruise begins either in Moscow or St.Petersburg and follows a network of lakes, channels and rivers that connect the two largest cities of Russia. The cruise includes a few days both in Moscow and St. Petersburg, where the ship is used as a hotel, while anchored in the harbour. The route of the trip passes by small and picturesque villages like Mandroga and Goritsy, the tiny island of Kizhi etc.

The ship: Built especially for river cruising and completely refurbished to a high standard in 2001, the M/S Dostoyevsky is today considered one of the finest vessels on Russia's waterways. The passenger number for these departures is restricted to 244, so with 110 crew. All of the Dostoyevsky's Main, Middle and Upper Deck cabins are outward facing with windows which open to spectacular Russia's exotic destinations. All cabins have private toilet/shower facilities, refrigerators, forced air controls, radio and ample closet space. Facilities on board include a restaurant, two bars, TV/video room, souvenir shop, library, hairdressing salon, piano bar, observation lounge and a sun deck. There are medical services on board and the ship is fully air conditioned. The ship is not equipped with wheelchair access and elevator. The ship do not have extensive soundproofing so you may hear noise from air-conditioning and other machinery onboard at any time.

The price includes: accommodations in all outside cabins, each with private bathroom facilities; full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner, however drinks are not included in the price) in the ship's restaurants; meal service begins with dinner on the day of embarkation and ends with breakfast on the day of disembarkation; captain's welcome Cocktail Reception; Gala farewell Dinner aboard; full sightseeing programs in each of the ports of call with local English speaking guides; transfer to/from the ship upon arrival/departure; Russian language and song lectures; nightly entertainment and dancing; daily aerobics; tour of the ship's bridge; port taxes.

The price does not include: Visa to Russia, insurances, flight tickets to/from Moscow / St. Petersburg, tips, drinks, optional tours in Moscow and St. Petersburg that can be ordered and paid onboard.
